Pink tights and pink ballet shoes

JAZZ:

Hair pulled back Any color leotard Black or tan tights Slip on jazz shoe

TAP:

Hair pulled back Any color leotard

Style and color of tap shoe are up to the discretion of the class instructor. **Children's tap shoes must have elastic, not ribbons – for their safety.

CONTEMPORARY:

Hair pulled back Any color leotard Footless tights Bare feet or foot undies

HIP HOP:

Hair pulled back Sneakers Fitted tops Loose bottoms

LYRICAL:

Hair pulled back Any color leotard Black, tan, or pink tights Tan foot undies

**Please note: The shoes you will wear all year long during the dance season may not necessarily be the ones you will wear at recital time because they must coordinate with the costume style. PLEASE work with your teacher regarding this matter.

Anyone that is not dressed properly will be asked to sit during class.

HOW TO ENROLL

You will also be responsible for the first month of tuition and a \$25.00 registration fee, which is non-refundable.

TUITION

Tuition is non-refundable and is not payable on a per-lesson basis. Monthly tuition is a flat rate and does not reflect the number of lessons in each month. June's tuition must be paid by the 1st or otherwise must be paid by cash or credit only. No checks will be accepted after June 1st.

Tuition is due the 1st of each month and will be considered delinquent after the 10th of the month at which a \$10.00 late fee will be charged **automatically**. There are NO REFUNDS or credits given for missed classes. Makeup lessons are available at no extra charge to cover any classes missed.

A \$30.00 fee will be charged on all NSF checks and paid by the check-writer. Legal action will be taken on all NSF checks not paid within 10 days.

**No student will be permitted to attend class if their account is 60 days past due.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

CLASS PLACEMENT

- *Students are placed in classes based on individual ability, effort, and progress NOT on their age or the number of years of previous dance experience.
- *The instructors determine class placement, NOT the parents, NO exceptions.
- *If you have any questions concerning your child's placement, please contact Jennifer for an appointment. Classes will not be interrupted for parental consultations. This takes away from class time and is not fair to the students.
- *NO class switching after October 1st.
- *We accept enrollment throughout the year. However, in order to participate in our annual recital, you must begin classes by November 1st.

RULES FOR DANCERS

- *No cell phones in class
- *No chewing gum during class
- *Proper dress code must be obtained
- *No jeans
- *Be on time for class
- *No jewelry (only small earrings)
- *No street shoes on the dance floor
- *Only closed drinking containers allowed
- *Name must be on all belongings
- *All students should have a dance bag
- *Shoes, bags, etc should be labeled with student's name

PARENT OBSERVATION

Parents will have the opportunity to observe their child at certain times during the dance year. The class observation windows will be open the last scheduled week of September, November, January, March, and May. The Dance Gallery advises all instructors to keep windows covered and doors closed to provide the students with maximized instruction time without distractions.
